A son, Angiolo Annapolis Marcus was born on 24 February 1832. He died in August 1836. A daughter, Mary Ann who was 17 in the 1851 census must have been born around 1834. Then a son, William James was born 23 February 1835 and baptised in St Lukes, 18 March Chelsea on 18 Mar 1835.
