

Edmund Dobson & Ann (Nancy Winn)

Married 24 July 1787 Hull. No.4365 Both of parish. Married by Robert Webster, curate. Both signed with a X. Married in the presence of John Winn and Sarah Winn.

1841: Edmund was in Dundee census. Nancy was in Bridlington census described as “independent”. She was living in as separate household from her daughter Hannah (Ainsworth).

Edmund        1845 33 Reform St.

Nancy died 4 April 1746 at Cliff Street, Bridlington Quay aged 80 (or, perhaps, since writing is difficult to read, 86). The death cert says she died 5 April 1846 and she was the widow of Edmund Dobson. The Hull Advertiser says she died on Sat 4<sup>th</sup> April and that she was the wife of Mr Edmund Dobson late of Bridlington, basketmaker. Death certificate was signed by what seems like “Mary Balk”
