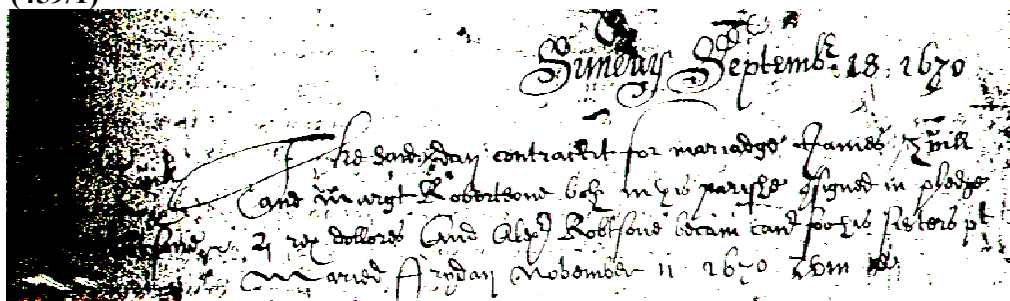

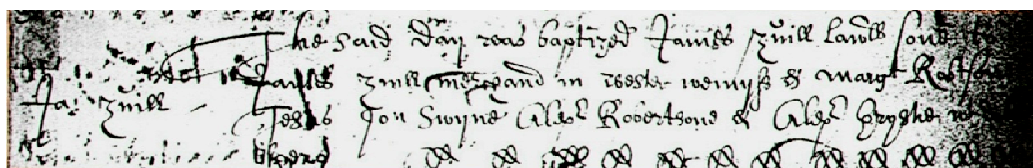

(A rix-dollar was a silver coin, used in many European countries e.g. Germany, Holland, Sweden, Denmark. It was the hard currency of the day. Everyone in West Weemys paid their pawns in rix-dollars, which seem to have been the local currency, so there may be no connection between the use of rix-dollars & James being a merchant who possibly traded with continental Europe.)
