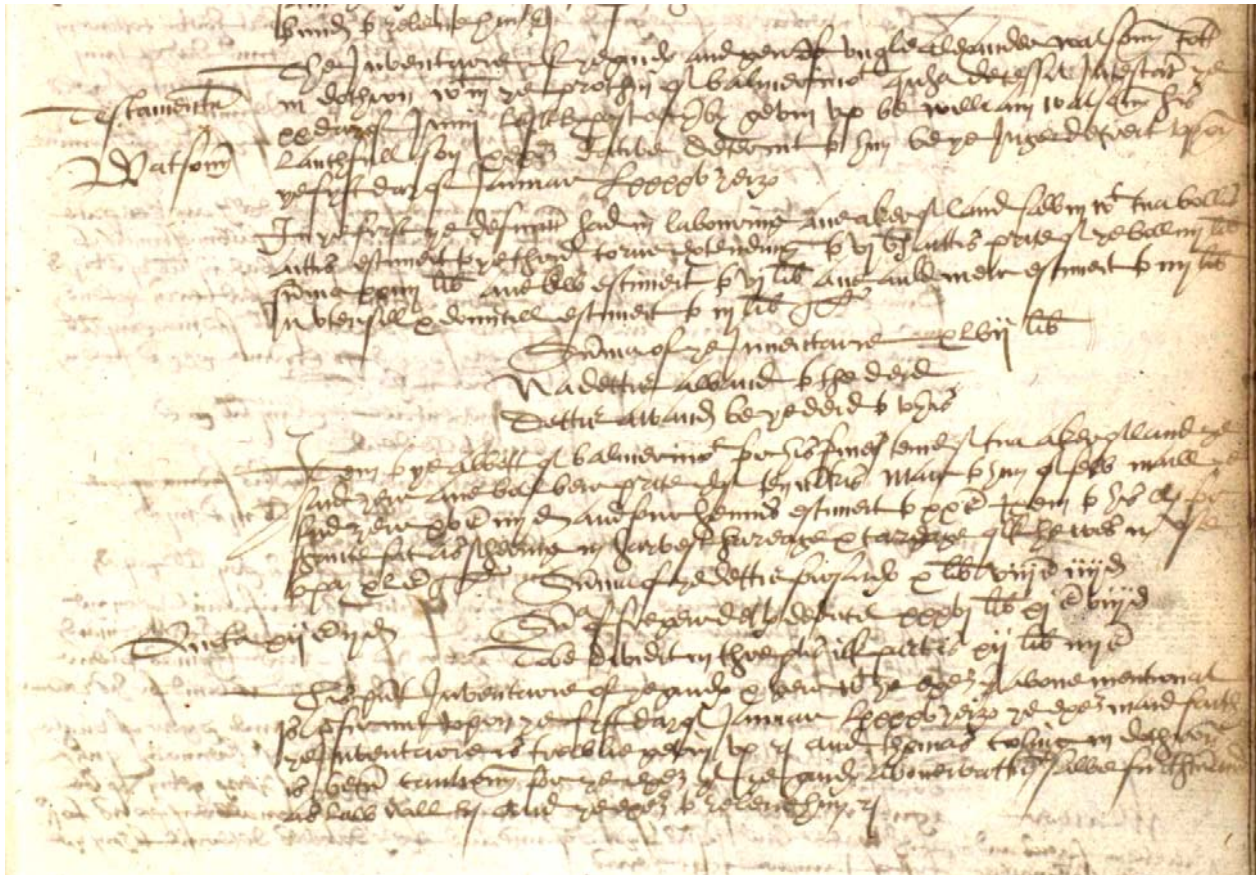


1596 Testament for Alexander Watson. Euphemia's uncle?



1. The Inventarie of the guids and gear of umqle Alexander Watson cottr in Dochron within the prochin of Balmerinoch wha deceased Intestate the 20th day of June last bypast (1595) given up by William Watson his lawful son executor dative determent? To him by the decret upon the fifth day of Januar '95 years.

(Goes into his possessions- an acre of land sown with oats at going estimated price etc)

Sum of Inventar £47

Na debts awand to the deid.

Debts awand by the deid: item to the Abbot of Balmerino for feu teinds of twa acres of land the said year boll bear and feu maill estimate to 20 merks

Item to his oy (grandchild) for plowing, harvest, forage & carriage which he was in hope to pay £10.

Total of Inventory came to £36 11s 8d.

This was to be divided in three parts ilk part £12.4s (This means there defunct was survived by widow and bairn(s).

The Inventarie performed upon the fifth day of januar '95, the executor faithfully given up and Thomas Coline in Dochron is become cautioner for the executor.
