
## John William Canham Elizabeth Helsdon Fuller



Both were of "full age". He a bachelor and she a spinster. He was a labourer and both were resident in Colby, Parish of Norwich. His father was Francis a labourer and her father, John, a labourer.




1881 13 Hinton Road, London (near Loughborough railway junction.)

In 1882 Alfred Frank was born.


