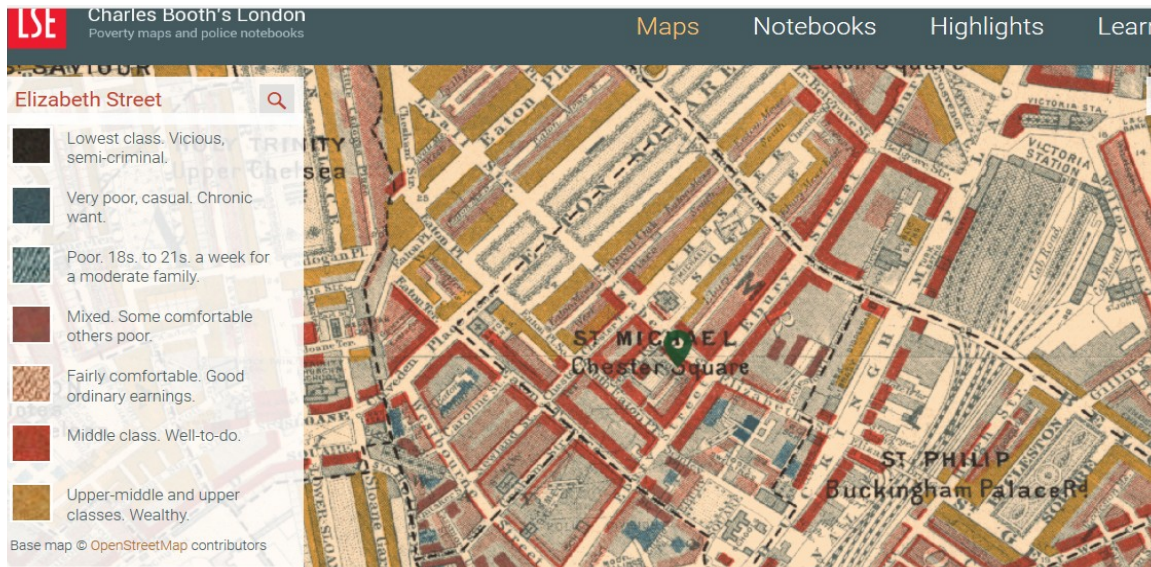

Bans were called in the Parish of Colby for John William Canham single man and Elizabeth Helsdon single woman, both of this parish on 7th, 14th, and 21st October 1866 and they were married in the Parish Church in the Parish of Colby on 27th October 1866. Both were of “full age”. He a bachelor and she a spinster. He was a labourer and both were resident in Colby, Parish of Norwich. His father was Francis a labourer and her father, John, a labourer.

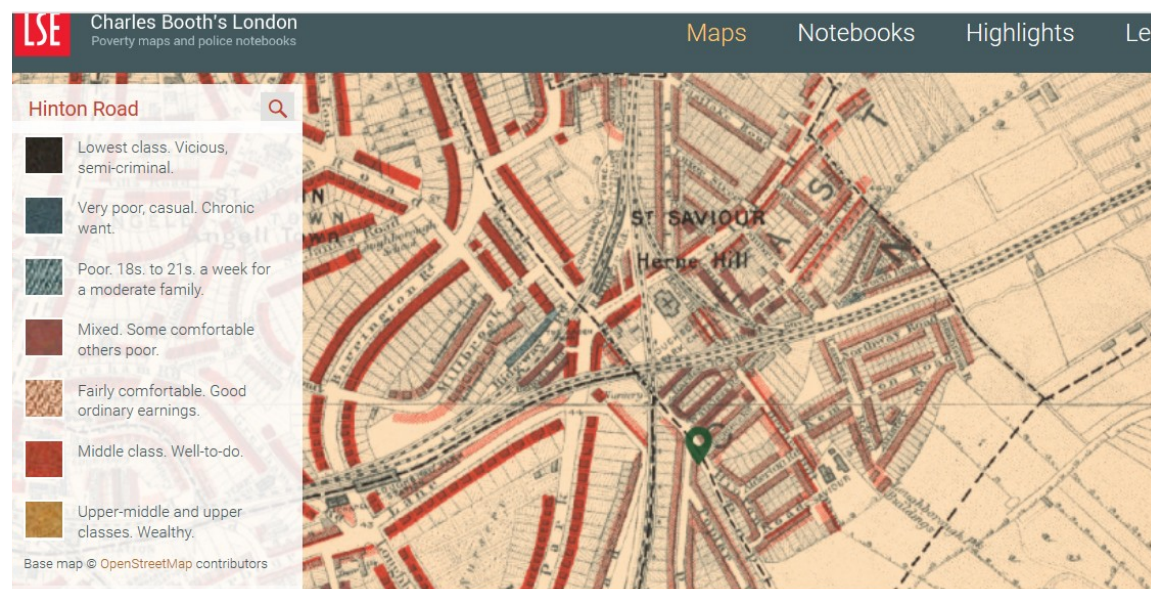

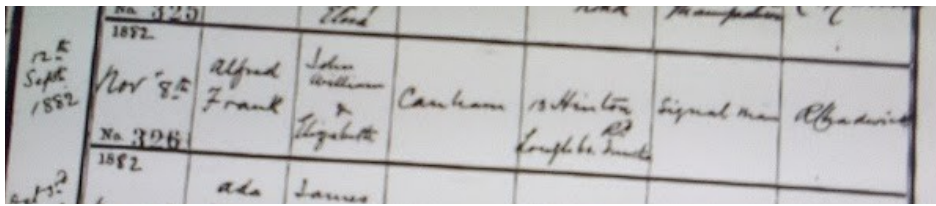

In 1882 Alfred Frank was born.

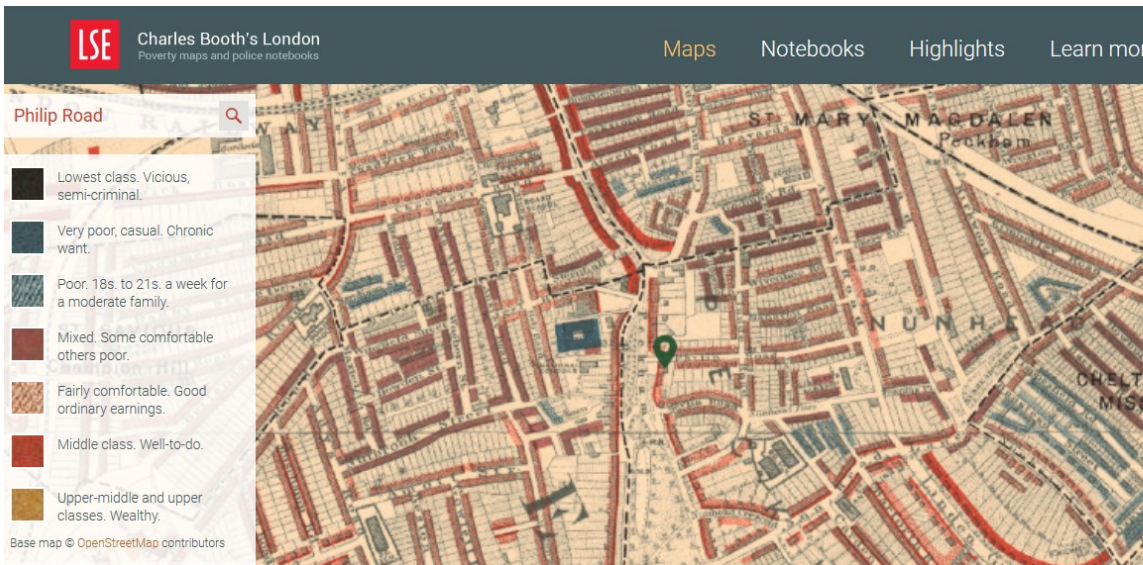
