

Joseph Hallahan Vallé Eliza Gladman

Joseph and Eliza were married in 1876 at St Stephens Church, Parish of Spitalfield, Middlesex. The information from the certificate is:

No. 320 March 12th 1876.

Husband: Joseph Hallihan Vallé, 29, bachelor, 47 St. Ann's Place, Bethnal Green father Joseph John Vallé, cheesemonger.

Wife: Eliza Evans, 30, widow, Princes Road, Hackney Road, father Thomas Gladman, house decorator.

Witnesses George Angus Dyer, Mary Sarah Vallé.

(There is a Princes Close near Finsbury Park but there may be others.)

Later in 1876 at Bethnal Green (Hackney Road sub-district), a birth was recorded.

No. 61. 24th September 1876 at 47 Ann's Place, Bethnal Green.

Child: Edith Elizabeth, father Joseph Hallahan Vallé, cheesemonger, mother Eliza Vallé late Evans, formerly Gladman. Informant: Joseph Hallihan Vallé 47 At Ann's Place, Bethnal Green.

Two more children were born before the 1881 census has at 49 Warrior Road, Lambeth:

Kate Evans, daughter, 8, scholar, Middlesex, Bethnal Green

The latter three are Eliza's children from her earlier marriage to Thomas Evans.

In the 1891 census we have at St. Saviour, Southwark. Newington St. Mary.

Joseph Vallé, head, married, 45, warehouseman at provision merchant, London city

Eliza Vallé, wife, married, 46, London Islington

Frances Evans, step daughter, single, 21, sun shade maker, London Hoxton

Sidney Evans, step son, single, 20, warehouseman, London Hackney

Kate Evans, step daughter, single, 18, worker at a painter, London Hackney

Edith Vallé, daughter, unmarried, 14, dressmaker, London Hackney

Joseph Vallé, son, unmarried, 12, scholar, London Hackney

Samuel Vallé, son, unmarried, 10, scholar, London Camberwell

The family have not been found in the 1901 census but in the 1911 census at 9 Lorrimore Road Walworth Southwark. Sub-district: Newington South. Dist. 6. Parish St.Mary Newington we have:

Samuel Valli, head, married, 30, butcher, London, Lambeth

Alice Valli, wife, married, 28, (married 4 years),

Samuel Valli, son, 3, London, Peckham

Frances Alice Valli, daughter, 2, London, Wealworth

Edith May Valli, daughter, 4months, London, Lambeth

Joseph Hannahan Valli, father, 66, London, Lambeth.

So Joseph senior is living with his son Samuel and his family. Presumably Eliza has died in the intervening twenty years.

In the 1871 census at 5½ Marian Place, Bethnal Green there is what appears to be Eliza with her first husband, who must have died between 1872 and 1876.

Thomas Evans, head, married, 28, copper plate painter, Msex Bethnal Green

Eliza Evans, wife, married, 28, Msex, Islington

Francis Evans, daughter, 2, Msex Shoreditch

Sidney Evans, son, 6months, ditto

The Evans line has not been followed up.
