James Youll This day was baptized David Youll lawful son to Baillie James Youll and Elizabeth Hutton witnesses Robert Youll and Archibald Conan

Elizabeth Youll James Youll merchant in Wester Weems and Elizabeth Hutton his wife had a daughter born on Thursday the 9<sup>th</sup> day of October and baptized Elizabeth on Sabbath the 12<sup>th</sup> October 1707. (Witnesses are named thereafter but the names are illegible.)

1708

David Youell James Youell merchant and present Baillie in West Wemys and Elizabeth Hutton his wife had a son born on Wednesday the 24<sup>th</sup> and baptized David on sabbath the 28<sup>th</sup> of Nover. 1708 witnesses Rott. Youell and Thomas Dawson.

1710

Helen Youell James Youell merchant in Wester Wemys and Elizabeth Hutton his wife had a daughter born on Thursday the 23 and baptized Helen on Sabbath the 26 of March 1710 witnesses Archibald Pringle Robert Youll and Thomas Dawson.

1714

Rot. Youell James Youell present Baillie in Wester Weems and Elizabeth Hutton his wife had a son born on Friday the sixteenth and baptized Robert on

Tuesday the 20<sup>th</sup> of July, Witnesses Robert Youell David Hoge  
William Robertson.

James Youell and late Baillie in Wester Wemys and Elizabeth Hutton  
his wife had a daughter born on Saturday the 14<sup>th</sup> January (The  
remainder is almost illegible but may say baptized sabbath 15<sup>th</sup> January  
and then name witnesses).
