

Sir David Forrester = Elizabeth Sandilands

Notes from Lands and Lairds of Larbert and Dunipace Parishes by John Charles Gibson published 1908.

Sir David Forrester of Torwood and Garden, who was provost of Stirling, 1546-7. He had a charter of the barony of Garden, 1<sup>st</sup> February, 1542. He married Elizabeth Sandilands, daughter of James Sandilands of St Monans.

His son Alexander succeeded him before June 1556.

Extract from Gordon MacGregor's Red Book of Scotland.

Sir David Forrester of Garden, who was styled *filio et herede apparente* to Sir James Forrester of Garden in a charter to him under the Great for the lands and barony of Garden-Forrester with the turret and fortalice, and also the lands of Torwoodhead with the office and custody of the forrest and fishings there, dated 9<sup>th</sup> September 1528<sup>1</sup>. He *m* Elizabeth, daughter of James Sandilands of Cruvie, with whom he had a charter under the great seal on 1<sup>st</sup> February 1541/2<sup>2</sup>. and was *k.* at the battle of Pinkie in September of 1547<sup>3</sup>. He was the father of Alexander Forrester of Garden.
